<p>Overtime this might reasonably include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reviewing and developing the curriculum policy in the subject(s). • Monitoring and evaluating the quality of planning in the subject(s) by other teachers. • Observing teaching in the subjects in order to evaluate the strengths and areas for development or the impact of school improvement work. • Evaluating relevant assessment information for individuals, groups or cohorts. • Suggesting issues in the subject(s) for further development. • Providing advice and supporting 'new' staff in the subject(s) • Reporting on the progress, achievement and standards in the subject(s) to staff, governors and parents • Arranging and promoting relevant subject activities to promote pupil's enthusiasm and interest.
