Evaluation of 2016/ 2017: What were the successes?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All DP children in Reception made outstanding progress in maths, 90% made good or better in reading and 80% good or better in writing. • The percentage of DP children exceeding ARE in GLD at the end of Reception was higher than others. • 80% of DP children in school made good or better progress in maths. • 75% of DP children in school made good or better progress in reading. • All DP pupils were at least at ARE in all subjects by the end of Year 6. • 50% of DP pupils exceeded ARE in maths at the end of KS2 • 66% of DP children passed phonics screening in Year 1 • Increased number of DP pupils in extra curricular clubs • Structured conversations with Post LAC pupils/Adopted from Care • Family Support Worker supporting families successfully in crisis with housing and income • Overall attendance for DP :94.7% • 3 Children, who were unlikely to attend University in the future, graduated from Brilliant Club with honours (1x 1st, 1x 2:1 and 1 x 2:2) 		
Priorities 2017-2018	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Induct new leader of DP provision • Employ additional teacher for Year 6 to narrow gaps in attainment by ensure all pupils make rapid progress specifically 9 DP in Reading Writing and Maths • Continue to reduce absences for DP pupils ensuring best attendance possible (target Y4/Y5) • Introduce structured conversations with targeted parent and pupils whom aren't engaging • Provide extra tuition for identified DP pupils to narrow gaps. 		
Success Criteria	<p>Academic Year 2017-2018: 64 are Eligible for DP Funding. 15 of these pupils will not be funded until January 2018 but are currently tracked. 1 will not be funded until January 2019 and 1 pupil is tracked but funding between countries is being debated.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disadvantaged Pupils making good or better progress in RWM in all year groups • Narrowed gaps between DP and Other pupils in school and against National expectations • Outstanding progress 13 months+ therefore narrowing gaps in high priority Year Groups • Further improvement in attendance of this group to 96% • Evidence of progress against identified barriers eg: improved parental engagement
